This information is of interest to GSRs - and helpful to GSRs to convey easy-to-access information to your home group members as follows:

- Do your members know that the <u>Big Book, the Twelve and Twelve, and all the pamphlets are available to</u> them for free on aa.org?
- Does your group know that there is an <u>online Newcomer Packet</u> they can use in a Zoom meeting?
- Do they know that the Fellowship has begun voting on whether to create a <u>new edition of the Big Book</u>?
 - Many think that "New York" makes these decisions, but Bill W. set up this service structure so that the groups are "the actual voice and effective conscience for our whole society." The groups will vote, through their delegate, on whether to create a new edition of the Big Book.

On page S27 of the Service Manual:

The <u>inverted triangle</u> graphically displays the service structure. It shows the general service representative linking his or her group with A.A. as a whole.

The graphic also shows that the ideal group service structure would include a representative for each District committee - and ideally that every GSR joins a District Committee.
